HANDBOOK - SECTION 4.

Classes 52 – 60 & 62 (page 10 in competition Handbook)

52	White beauty	An arrangement not more than 90cm wide to be arranged in your choice of container or vase. Use fresh, white flowers
53	Gardens of Versailles	An arrangement of not more than 70cm, Using a colorful range of seasonal flowers and foliage. An Art piece is to be incorporated with the arrangement.
54	Teacup floral arrangements	The arrangement should be in a Tea cup with the entire display, including accessories, being not more than 50cm wide. Use fresh cut flowers.
55	Celebrating the Nature	An arrangement which represents the vision of nature, not more than 70cm wide, mixing flowers, leaves and branches all mixed with dried flowers and natural accessories.
56	Lilies arranged with palm leaves	An arrangement not more than 30cm wide and 40cm high incorporating colorful range of flowers along with lilies and palm leaves. A background niche measuring 35cm wide x 55cm high will be provided for your exhibit.
57	Gleaming in purples and gold	An arrangement in any container use fresh purple flowers with gold accents must be gleaming (shining).
58	Women's World	A novice class which is restricted to those who have never won a prize in a previous show). The arrangement should not be more than 70cm wide.
59	Creating a green arrangement	A green arrangement using herbs, foliage and green flowers. Not larger than 40 x 30 cm.
60	Eco Friendly Petite Floral Arrangements	All principles of design is applied but in tiny dimensions. Maximum dimension should not exceed 10cm overall. Your choice of containers using small, fresh flowers and foliage
62	Ikebana	c. Special Occasions (Tea ceremony).
